



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

N^o **1000016** AAC/ASSA-AC/EFO-CCAA of **30 JUL 2025** for the selection of twenty (20) students for admission to a Specialised Master's degree Program in Aircraft Maintenance and Recycling (CAMRA).

As part of its support towards the sustainable development of the air transport industry, the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO-CCAA), in partnership with the Central African Air navigation Safety Agency (ASSA-AC), the European Vallair group, and the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY) of the University of Yaoundé I in Cameroon, is launching the third batch of the Diploma in Aircraft Maintenance and Recycling (CAMRA).

This training program is open to all nationalities.

Graduates of this high-level technical and practical training program, of a twelve (12) months total duration, will be qualified to occupy managerial positions in organisations with the following profiles:

- Approved Aircraft Maintenance Organisations, including those specialised in aircraft dismantling and recycling;
- Aircraft dismantling organisations;
- Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisations, either independently or within an airline;
- Civil Aviation Administrations (Civil Aviation Authorities, Ministries, Accident Investigation Offices, etc.); and
- All other related organisations.

The CAMRA training program is led by experienced instructors from the aviation industry (pilots, aeronautical engineers, and aircraft mechanics), lecturers from the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY) and other academics in the fields of maintenance and production.

The courses will begin in **November 2025** and will last nine (09) months on the premises of the EFO-CCAA and the NASEY, followed by a three (03)-month professional internship in an aviation company.



a) REQUIRED PROFILE

- Have an Engineering degree / Master of Science (M.Sc) in Engineering / Master of Engineering (M.Eng)/in the following fields: mechanical, electrical, electrotechnical, industrial, electromechanical and telecommunications, or any other equivalent degree; or
- Have a Bachelor's of Engineering degree + (02) years' professional experience in the aforementioned fields; or
- Have an Aircraft Maintenance Licence (Cat B1, B2) with at least 05 years' experience in the field; and
- Have a good written and spoken command of French and/or English.
- Be at most 35 years as at December 31, 2025.

b) SELECTION PROCEDURE

First stage: submission of applications to the Civil Aviation Authorities (CAA) of each state and ASSA-AC;

Second stage: Pre-selection of ten (10) candidates, according to the internal procedure of each CAA with the assistance of ASSA-AC.

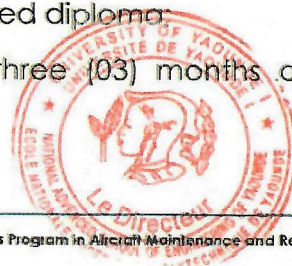
Third Stage: Psychotechnical tests and online oral interviews in English and French for shortlisted candidates organised by EFO-CCAA in collaboration with ASSA-AC;

Fourth Stage: Publication of the final list of admitted candidates.

The registration form is available on the website <https://efo-ccaa.com/camra-2/> and all the documents listed below must be attached to this form when submitting the applications as indicated in **point C:**

- A motivation letter addressed to the **Director of the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority (CCAA) Training School;**
- A certified true copy of birth certificate;
- A copy of a valid identity document (passport or National Identity Card);
- A curriculum vitae;
- A medical certificate issued within the last three (03) months;
- A copy of the required degree or the Aircraft Maintenance Licence (AML);
- A certificate or document authenticating the required diploma;
- A criminal record extract dated within the last three (03) months or an equivalent document;
- Two (02) colour 4x4 photos on a white background;

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- For holders of an Aircraft Maintenance Licence (AML), a copy of the AML booklet certifying professional experience and validated by the CAA;
- The payment receipt of twenty-five thousand (25,000) FCFA representing the application processing fee. These fees are paid to each CAA against issuance of a receipt.

NB:

- ***Incomplete, non-compliant or late applications will not be reviewed;***
- ***Only pre-selected candidates, whose names will be published, will be admitted to undergo the psychotechnical tests and oral examination.***

d) DATE AND VENUE OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

The psychotechnical tests and oral selection interviews will be conducted online from **September 8 to 10, 2025**.

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f) TUITION FEES

The tuition fees for the program are set at **three million five hundred thousand (3,500,000) FCFA**.

g) ASSA-AC SCHOLARSHIP

The two (02) best candidates admitted per CEMAC Member State (Cameroon, Central African Republic, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea and Chad) will receive a scholarship from ASSA-AC covering tuition fees and a monthly living allowance for the entire duration of the training program.

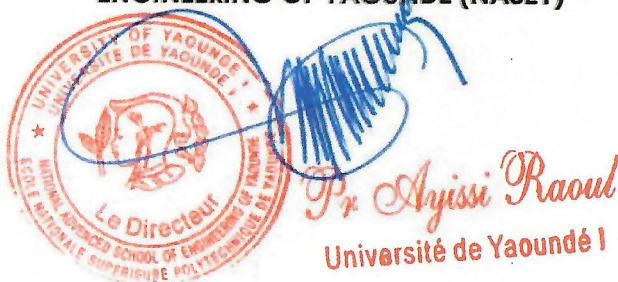
One (01) particularly outstanding candidate will also be selected for the needs of ASSA-AC and will receive similar treatment.
