FOR THE SELECTION OF THIRTY (30) SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS TO PURSUE A
BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN AIR NAVIGATION AND AERODROME SERVICES
OPERATIONS (ESNAA)

As part of its mission to support the sustainable development of the air transport industry, the Central African Agency for the Oversight of Air Safety (ASSA-AC), in partnership with the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO-CCAA), the European Vallair Group and the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY) of the University of Yaounde 1, is organising a competitive examination to award scholarships for admission to the second batch of the Bachelor's degree programme in Air Navigation and Aerodrome Services Operations, for secondary school graduates who aspire to a career within Civil Aviation Authorities and in the operational services of domestic or international airports.

This training programme, open to nationals of the member states of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC), aims to address the shortage of qualified technical staff within its member states in the short and medium term, both in the fields of safety oversight and in the industry.

Graduates of this high-level technical and practical course, which will last for a total of three (03) years, will be qualified to hold the following positions simultaneously:

- AFIS Officer (Aerodrome Flight Information Service);
- AIM Officer (Aeronautical Information Management);
- Airport Operations Technician; and
- Any other related activities.

The ESNAA training programme is facilitated by experienced instructors from the aviation industry (pilots, aeronautical engineers, air traffic controllers), lecturers from the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY) and other academics in the relevant fields.

Classes will begin in **October 2026** and will run for three (03) years at the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO-CCAA), located at the entrance of Yaounde Nsimalen International Airport, and in the premises of the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY). Professional internships will be carried out regularly in companies within the aviation sector.

a) REQUIRED PROFILE

- Be a holder of a scientific baccalaureate; or
- Be a holder of a technical baccalaureate; or
- Be a holder of a GCE Advanced Level in Sciences; and
- Have a good command of French and/or English;
- Be **at most 30 years as at 31 December 2026**.

b) SELECTION PROCEDURE

- **First stage:** Submission of applications as indicated in point (c);
- **Second stage:** Publication of the list of candidates admitted to sit for the examination following review of their applications;
- **Third stage:** Written mathematics and physics papers;
- **Fourth stage:** Publication of the final list of admitted candidates.

- A cover letter addressed to the Director of the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO – CCAA);
- A curriculum vitae;
- A certified copy of the birth certificate;
- A copy of a valid identification document (passport or national identity card);
- A medical certificate issued within the last three (3) months;
- An extract from the criminal record (Bulletin No. 3) issued within the last three (03) months or an equivalent document;
- Two (02) colour passport size photographs on a white background;

The written examinations will take place simultaneously across all CEMAC member states on **15th September 2026**, in accordance with the timetable below. The examinations will take place at the examination centres in each State of the Community as follows:

f) ASSA-AC SCHOLARSHIPS

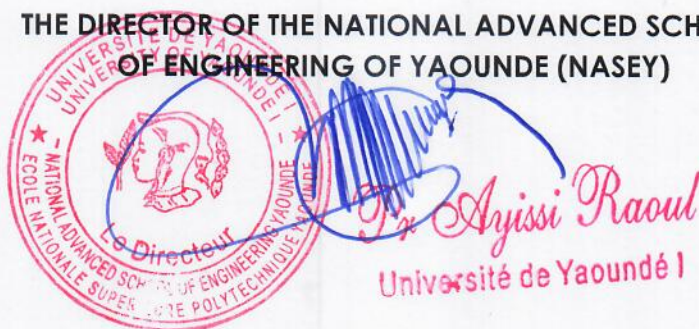
The five (05) best candidates finally admitted from each CEMAC member state (Cameroon, the Central African Republic, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea and Chad) will receive from ASSA-AC a scholarship covering tuition fee, a travel voucher from their country of origin to EFO-CCAA, and a monthly stipend throughout the duration of the training.
